### **Abstract:**

The Harlem Development Archive, an archival collection within the City College Libraries Archives and Special Collections Division was established in 2005 by library faculty during the *Changing Streetscapes: New Architecture & Open Space in Harlem* exhibit at the City College of New York to preserve and collect materials about Harlem's ongoing development in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

The collection documents social conditions, demographic change, architectural history, urban policy, design and planning in Community Districts 9 (Morningside Heights, Manhattanville and south and West Harlem), CD 10 (Central Harlem) and CD 11 (East Harlem) with a strong emphasis on the urban renewal periods of the 1980's, 1990's and 2000's. The records span from the 1970s, and include: government reports, theses, dissertations, video recordings, photographs, monographs, maps, magazine and newspaper clippings, promotional and real estate advertisements, correspondence and records of organizations and government agencies.

### **Scope & Content:**

The Harlem Development Archive consists of records, reports, documents, theses and dissertations that relate to Harlem's ongoing redevelopment from the 1970s. Government records include reports and studies commissioned by state agencies and nonprofits. Photographs consist of buildings, vacant lots and construction sites documenting the evolution of Harlem's redevelopment. Maps, blueprints and building plans include preliminary and presentation drawings as well as renderings. Monographs, audio visual recordings, magazine and newspaper clippings, real estate listings, advertisements and brochures are included. The archive also includes exhibit materials and records from the *Changing Streetscapes: New Architecture & Open Space in Harlem* exhibition.

### **Organization:**

The original order of materials was maintained where applicable and re-created in others to assist researchers more easily. Subject files at the folder level are either arranged chronologically or alphabetically.
