

The second meeting of the joint Com. of Am. for the Benefit of the
N.Y. & A. was held in Room No 10, F.C. on Thursday, Apr 26th,
1866, at 1 o'clock, P.M. The Soph. Fresh. Clivian, Phenocopian,
& Grecian delegations were present at roll-call. The Secretary
then stated that the minutes of the last meeting were missing,
& had probably been lost. They were then adopted under protest.
A delegation of three ^{from the former day} presented itself, stating that the late
delegation of seven had been discharged, and their appointment
in its place, but owing to the absence of the Pres. & Sec. they had no
written materials. It was then moved, seconded, & carried, by
a vote of 2151 that they be admitted, in their name, to represent the
Junior class. Misses Willis & Bonker then reported amount of cash
rec'd by them. The Com. m Coffin then reported that a small coffin
could be hired for \$1. a night from, & that a pall would cost \$2
for him. It was moved that they be directed to buy the coffin, and
that \$5 be appropriated to them. This previous question was
carried & the motion carried. The Com. m Order of Excuse & Pun-
ishing then reported ^{nothing}, which upon motion was unanimously
adopted. Moved and seconded to continue the Com. m Band,
and that all the surplus money be appropriated to them.
It was amended that drums be provided instead of a band, lost.
The motion was then carried. Misses Curr & Angel rec'd a vote
of thanks. (The finance Com. then reported the following:-
Pa. Soph. 14.05, Fresh. 6.00; ~~surplus~~, Soph. 1.00 ~~surplus~~,
- total \$32.05) On motion, the following appropriations were
made: - Punishing \$5.00, Contingent Expenses \$5.00, & (addi-
tional \$3.00) It was moved, seconded & carried that the band
be hired for last three hours. It was then carried to proceed
to the election of officers: - Mr Brinkhoff was then elected
Marshal for the Junior class unanimously. Misses Kelly &
Brugman were nominated ^{for Marshal of the Soph.} and it was voted a petition to

Wes Bragton & Nom were then unanimously elected, Mr. Summing having also been nominated
as ^{surrogate} for the Chairman. Mr Gould was elected
Treasurer Marshal unanimously. Moved that
a Marshal be appointed for those junior members
to participate, who should also collect subscriptions
from his class. Moved as an amendment that
he be chosen to appoint one for each duty, which
was carried. Mr Kimball was then elected First
Agent & Mr Arkinson, Marshal. The following
officers were then unanimously elected. Gram-
diggers, Mc Adam, Parker, & Becht. Grand Un-
dertaker, Enrich. Pall Bearers; Hall, Vandribits,
Bush, Elliott, Angel, Cuse, Conson, & Mackie.
Chief Mourners, Hittava. Mourners; McMaster,
Glauchmidt, Wilds, Van Schaick. Undertakers;
W. D. Clark, C. A. Norton, Summing, Stelly, &
Simmons. Carried that the Secretary be impo-
vered to have slips printed with a sort of programme
for distribution in the following morning.
The meeting then adjourned.
